Mark Shoenfelder , engineer from Ridgeline Group was paid \$1,634.12 for the same road work.

R. Rotty noted fiber optics will be installed, that will include Jacob Ave. The Township does not ask for a fee or require a permit.


A Girl Scout group spoke with R. Rotty about using the Town Hall every Wed. night for meetings. Everyone was in agreement this would be fine.
