1. **Meeting called to order** by Bob Rotty at 7 pm
2. **Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.**

Fire numbers are rusty and need to be replaced. Who is responsible for this? will need to be replaced. If the sign needs to be replaced the homeowner will need contact the township and they will replace it. The homeowner is responsible for the cost of replacing the sign.

  - B. **MRCCA final approval**---Everything is complete, and we have received the final approval of everything. This will be filed in the ordinance book under Ordinance 14-C.
  - C. **Water in Town Hall**---Larry Neuman---Need to have someone to improve the water to be drinkable. The odor needs to be mitigated. Larry will contact well drillers but will need assurance that the smell will no longer be a problem and the water will be drinkable. Larry will continue to continue with the water and be paid hourly.
  - D. **Dakota County Officers Association meeting**—Saturday, March 19, 2022—David given agenda and he will possibly attend. The other board members will be attending except for Margaret.
  - E. **Phone Service/High Speed Internet for town hall**---HBC has been contacted and will be installing high speed internet shortly. The monthly bill will be considerably less than with Century Link. We will still have a land line.

  - A. **Lock Blvd striping**--Bob stated the Lock Blvd will be striped as soon as weather permitting. Karen moved to pay the bill as per contract with funds coming from the American Rescue Plan funding, seconded by David. All ayes.

  - C. **Road Inspection** needs to be done before April 19. David, Bob, and Karen will do road inspection with Luhman's.
