1. **Meeting called order by Bob Rotty at 7 pm.**
2. The **Pledge of Allegiance** was recited by everyone.
3. **Approval of Agenda** Motion was made by Karen to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Dave. All yes. Motion carried.
4. **Approval of Minutes of Board of Supervisors** –July 15, 2025 meeting A motion was made by Dave to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Karen. All ayes. Motion carried.

5. **Treasurer’s Report**—Margaret Flower

6. **Building Permits**---Bob Rotty

- a. **Kelly & Jason Murtaugh-** Dave moved to approve the building permit for 10555 140th Street. A check for \$1388.44 was received. Motion seconded by Karen. All ayes. Motion carried.
- b. **Robert & Michaela Silker-**Karen moved to approve the building permit for pool at 10555 132nd St. A check received for \$1087.19. Motion was seconded by Dave. All ayes. The motion carried.

7. **Public Comment:** Visitors may share their concerns with the Town Board on any issue.
 - Mike Slavik**—Many capital improvement project was approved. Among those approvals were several roundabouts for rural areas. Goodwin Ave and Hwy 46 has been very successful. There has only been one minor accident in the area since the roundabout was complete. Prior to that there were accidents averaging every 3 days. This round about will be used as a model for the other round abouts. The intersection of Hwy 55 and 42 will be updated in 2029. There will be an open house on Sept 30 at Schaar’s bluff regarding park updates and plan for new construction. There is no plan for county to take over Hiliary Path. At the township Officers meeting in Sept there will be a panel of water and environmental resources. It will be regarding where to go for information regarding water and environmental problems.
8. **Road & Bridges Report**---Bob Rotty
 - a. **Lock Blvd Project**-The black topping for project is completed and the invoice will be paid today. The striping process will be finalized soon.
9. **Fire Report**---David Bauer-There is nothing new from the Rural Fire Association. The Hastings Fire Department has a new ambulance and is waiting for a new ladder truck.
10. **Town Hall Maintenance/Correspondence**--Karen Bremer-Harrison Benjamin submitted pictures of town hall and historical signs to MN Association of Township for publication. They will be published in the fall issue. She issued 2 burning permits.
11. **Old Business**
 - a. **Fence Ordinance**-- A motion was made by Dave to approve a \$400.00 fee for a fence permit and was seconded by Karen. A Public Hearing is scheduled at the Planning Commission meeting on Oct. 6 at 8 pm in Nininger Town Hall. This information will be published.

 - c. **Voting Equipment Replacement Overview 2025**- Margaret has been attending meetings regarding the purchasing of new voting equipment. It is planned to have the decision made by the end of September.
