FENCE ORDINANCE NO. 2022-03 PUBLIC HEARING

- COMMENTS/QUESTIONS: Chair Bremer called for questions or comments regarding draft Fence Ordinance No. 2022-03, submitted by township attorney Mike Hamilton and distributed at the July 7, 2025, Planning Commission Regular Meeting.
 - A question was raised about how the new ordinance would affect existing fences. Bremer stated he believed fences previously installed would be “grandfathered in” as that has been the practice with other new ordinances in the past; however, a final decision would be up to the Township Board.
 - No further questions or comments were raised.
- **Motion:** Mary Dalaska made a motion to recommend the Township Board, at their Dec. 16, 2025, meeting, approve Fence Ordinance No. 2022-03 as submitted by Attorney Mike Hamilton. The motion was seconded by Ted Wagner. **Member vote:** 5 Ayes; 0 Opposed. **Motion carried.**
